Adverse Weather Procedures

I wish to remind parents of the procedures should we be forced to close the school due to adverse weather conditions.

If snow falls during the night and conditions dictate that staff/students cannot travel to school, we will contact you **via text** to inform you that the school is closed. Please ensure that the school has your updated contact information as a matter of urgency. We will also use the school's social media pages (Twitter @deaneryhigh or Facebook /TheDeanery) to communicate information.

Following the text notification, the school website will be updated regularly with the latest information and advice, as will the Council's website. You can also listen to Wish FM, the local radio station, who will broadcast school closure details.

In order to safeguard your child in the unlikely event of school closure during the day, we will send you a text message and will send your child home **unless you inform us not to**. If you do not wish your child to make his/her own way home, please inform their Head of Year in writing and we will arrange supervision until an authorised person can collect them at the end of the school day. It is vital that your child is aware of these arrangements.

If the school has to remain closed, students are able to log on to their own account to complete work which has been set, using the link on the school website.
