## CEIAG at the Deanery High School & 6th Form College

Measuring and assessing the impact of the careers programme

- The Deanery High School and 6<sup>th</sup> form college on a termly basis (3 times across the school academic year) completes the Careers and Enterprise Company's (CEC) Compass Careers Benchmark Tool to track and evaluate our career's provision against the Gatsby Benchmarks.
- At the end of each academic year pupil and parental opinions are gathered through the use of surveys and results are used to measure the impact of careers provision and inform future planning.
- Pupils and external provider feedback is collated following significant careers events, namely the annual Careers Fair and Year 11 Mock Interviews. The results are used to measure impact and inform future planning.
- Destination data is used to establish whether the schools careers provision is providing the right advice and guidance for all pupils, to ensure that the guidance and opportunities that they have are enabling them to make the next steps successfully.
